FELLOWSHIP OVERVIEW

RUTGERS UNIVERSITY CENTER FOR HEALTH OUTCOMES, POLICY, AND ECONOMICS (HOPE)

The Rutgers University Center for Health Outcomes, Policy, and Economics (HOPE) partners with scientists, clinicians, and stakeholders from academia, pharmaceutical, biotech, and other marketplace innovators to conduct interdisciplinary research that produces relevant, meaningful health economic models and analyses to facilitate the adoption of cost-effective healthcare and improve patient outcomes.

HOPE and Novo Nordisk are partnering to offer a Fellowship program in Health Economics and Outcomes Research (HEOR). The Fellowship combines applied industry experience at Novo Nordisk and academic HEOR training through HOPE.

Composed of practical research experience, didactic courses, and seminars, the program provides training in the application of real world evidence to support Novo Nordisk products in diabetes and obesity using real world data.

The Fellow will primarily work on-site at Novo Nordisk with researchers in Plainsboro, New Jersey. The Fellow will have the opportunity to learn about the application of health economics and outcomes research in an academic setting at the Rutgers HOPE Center one day per week. The Fellow may enroll in graduate courses towards a Certificate or the Rutgers Master of Science in Health Outcomes, Policy, and Economics.
